Some examples of CONJUNCTIONS

| ● although | ● but | ● or | ● unless |
| ● and | ● even if | ● since | ● when |
| ● as soon as | ● for | ● so | ● whenever |
| ● because | ● just as | ● so that | ● whereas |
| ● before | ● nor | ● though | ● yet |

Some examples of INTERJECTIONS

- | | | |
|----------|-------------------------|--|
| ● aah | expression of fear | <i>"Aah! There's a big spider on my back!"</i> |
| ● oops | expression of a mistake | <i>"Oops! I dropped the eggs."</i> |
| ● ouch | expression of pain | <i>"Ouch! That hurts!"</i> |
| ● uh-oh | expression of dismay | <i>"Uh-oh. We're late."</i> |
| ● uh-huh | expression of agreement | <i>"Uh-huh, that's right."</i> |
| ● wow | expression of surprise | <i>"Wow! That's a big dog!"</i> |
