

Modals are is a special group of verb which we add to another verb base.

These verbs add special meaning to the main verb. Most of you have studied these verbs already, so this is a quick reminder. You should know the modal on this page for the next quiz.

Modal Verbs-Special Verbs you need to know

Meanings

| I can swim | This is about an ability. |
| Can I swim? | This is a request. (Less formal) |
| I may swim later. | This is about a possibility. |
| May I swim with you? | This is a request (formal and a little out of date) |
| I might swim later. | This is another possibility. |
| I have to swim daily. | This shows a strong need or necessity to swim. |
| I will swim later. | This shows a decision to swim in the future. |
| I had to swim yesterday. | This showed a past need to swim. |

How do we form verbs with modals?

In the sentences above the **main verb** is **swim**. When we use modals we never make changes to the main verb. Also most of the time the modals don't change.

I/you he/She/It/We/They can swim.

I/you he/She/It/We/They may swim.

I/you he/She/It/We/They might swim.

I/you he/She/It/We/They will swim.

Have to is an **exception**. The base verb doesn't change but the modal changes. We use have to, has to, had to and will have to.

I'm sorry but I **have to** go now.

He **has to** go soon.

Yesterday I **had to** leave before class was finished.

You **will have to** know these for the next grammar quiz.

Other Modals

I **must** be on time for exams.

Must is strong necessity. Like **have to**

You **must not** talk in exams.

Must not means don't do something.

I **should** study a bit more.

Should shows obligation. Not as strong as must or have to.

I **ought to** study a bit more.

Ought to is like **should**; it shows need.
